

ORDINANCE NO. _____
CITY OF SUMNER, WASHINGTON

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY OF SUMNER ZONING CODE REGULATIONS AMENDING SECTIONS 18.44.110; OF THE SUMNER MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, to address the advertising of marijuana businesses and products; and

WHEREAS, to create buffers from certain specific uses; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments are consistent with the City's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City's State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) official issued a Determination of Nonsignificance on September 19; and

WHEREAS, on September 6, 2017 notice was sent to the Washington State Department of Commerce requesting expedited review. On September 21, 2017 the City was granted expedited review and was informed that it had met the Growth Management Act notice requirements under RCW 36.70A.106; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on October 19, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City Council Community Development Committee reviewed the proposed amendment on September 12, 2017 and recommended it be added to Councils consent agenda with a due pass recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUMNER, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That section 18.44.110(O) "Prohibited Signs," of the Sumner Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

O. Signage advertising marijuana businesses or products within 2,000 feet of the following uses:

1. Churches,
2. Residential,
3. Libraries,
4. Parks,
5. Trails,
6. Daycare facilities, or
7. Schools

Section 2. Corrections by City Clerk or Code Reviser. Upon approval of the City Attorney, the City Clerk and the Code Reviser are authorized to make the necessary corrections to this ordinance,

including the correction of clerical errors; ordinance, section, or subsection numbering; or references to other local, state, or federal laws, codes, rules, or regulations.

Section 3. Severability – Construction. If a section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction; such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. If the provisions of this ordinance are found to be inconsistent with other provisions of the Sumner Municipal Code, the provisions of this ordinance shall control.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
