

SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

Project Name: MANUFACTURED HOME PARK OVERLAY ZONE

Permit Application: SEPA-2025-0009

Location: City-wide

Description of Proposal: The Zoning Code text amendment would create a Manufactured Home Park (MHP) overlay district under Sumner Municipal Code chapter 18.34 that would limit the future use of the land to being only a MHP. The amendments would specify that MHP is the only allowed use in this overlay; creates an option for owners of MHPs to apply for a use exception if the overlay zone prevents reasonable use of the property or it is not economically viable. Displacement provisions would be available for residents if the MHP ceased to exist; and would allow for residents of the MHP to apply to the City for a MHP Overlay Zone if the residents become vulnerable to displacement.
