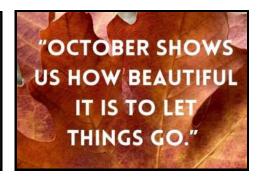

Welcome Anne Lee!

Come take a Jewelry class with Anne who has been a member since May of this year.

Here is a little about Anne. She spent the first half of her career working in banking, and the second half owning four small businesses and working with nonprofit organizations. In 2024, she retired after the nonprofit she worked for faced budget constraints that eliminated her position. While that was initially a

disappointment, she saw it as a positive opportunity to start a new chapter.

She relocated to be closer to her children and settled into a tiny home on her daughter's property—a cozy space that fits her just right. Since then, she's become actively involved in her community, including the YMCA and our Senior Center, plus she's completed certification through the Ombudsman program.

One day at the Senior Center, someone complimented her on the earrings she was wearing — which led to the creation of "Jewelry with Anne," a new class that we offer. She has been making earrings, hair clips, and necklaces for over a decade, but she says teaching others how to create their own pieces has brought a new layer of joy to the craft.

Another passion of Anne's is gardening. Even with the limited space around her tiny home, she's managed to plant beds of both flowers and vegetables. Watching things grow and sharing plants with friends and neighbors brings her a lot of happiness — especially when she can give potted plants to others with more room to nurture them.

Since retiring, Anne has rekindled her love of travel. Now her aim is to take at least a couple of trips each year. So far, she has explored Australia, New Zealand, and Ireland, with future adventures planned for Mexico and Croatia. Traveling solo is a new experience for her— not without its challenges — but she's embracing the independence and the excitement of discovering new places.

Anne's favorite moments in life have been the births of her two children. Parenting — and grandparenting — comes with its fair share of challenges, but it's also full of joy, humor, and growth. She tries to find laughter in everyday moments, and that sense of humor helps her stay optimistic.
